You are invited to take part in the open international competition for control line flying wing F-2-D model aircraft, which will take place in Kiryat Gat on 30 – 31 March 2007.

KIRYAT GAT

Historical Background and Geographical Location

Kiryat Gat is situated 56 kilometers south of Tel Aviv and 60 kilometers southwest of Jerusalem. The population is about 60,000. The town is a center of modern hi-tech industries. Intel and Hewlett-Packard operate their plants here.

THE AIM OF THE COMPETITION

- The popularization of one of the most spectacular classes of aircraft modeling
- Improvement of the participants' skills and qualification
- Exchange of know-how.

THE PROGRAM.

29 March 2007	Arrival, accommodation, registration.
30 March 2007	Competitions opening. Beginning of flights.
31 March 2007	Competitions continued. Closure of competitions.
1 April 2007	Participants' departure.

RULES OF COMPETITION

The individual and team competitions will be held in accordance with the FAI code and the present regulations. Each team may include three crews and a judge.

ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION.

All sportsmen are eligible irrespective of age and qualification.

PARTICIPATION FEE.

National currency equivalent to \$30 US. Participants born before 1989 will pay \$15 US.
Insurance – 90 Shekels.

APPLICATION FOR PARTICIPATION.

Applications for participation will be accepted till 15 February 2007. Delayed applications will be accepted with a 30% increase of the stated participation fee.

ROOM AND BOARD

Accommodation in the hotels of Ashkelon at the expense of the participants. The Organizing Committee will assist in finding accommodation in accordance with participants' requests.

Board – at the competition site. Buffet at the start.

FUEL AND LUBRICATION OIL SUPPLY.

Fuel and oil will be supplied by the organizers: payment in cash. Prior orders are welcome.

JUDGES

Each team includes one judge. The rest of the judges are invited by the organizers.

AWARDS

Winners will be awarded 5,000 US dollars and a diploma.

Second prize - 3,000 US dollars and a diploma.

Third prize - 1,000 US dollars and a diploma.

The winner of the Team Competition will be awarded the Israeli Aeroclub Cup.

TRANSPORTATION

At the participants' expense.
