Final registration takes place on 13. and 14.07.2002 at our reception
at the main entrance of the World Championship Centre.

It is open from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

The team managers are requested to register their participants
in the competitions on these two days.

Financial differences will be solved during this registration.

Official training sessions as well as the model aircraft inspection and approval
begin on 15.07.02 at 8 a.m.

Two adjacent equal flight circuits are available for F2B on the official training day.

After the official training the second circuit will only be available for F2C training.
For F2A a circuit for competitions and for training purposes is available.

The plans how to get to your accommodation will be given to you
at the reception centre at the main entrance.

Parking spaces directly at the World Championship Centre will only be available for
the team managers (1 each).

All other vehicles cannot be parked directly on the World Championship grounds.

**To unload your cars you can drive up to the main entrance, afterwards the cars
have to be parked on the relevant car park. The main car park is located some
1000 m from the World Championship Centre.**

You may use one of the frequently travelling free shuttle buses.

There will be sufficient additional fast food stalls for the participants and visitors.

We have prepared a comprehensive programme of outings to sightseeing attractions in our region for our guests. These can be booked at the reception centre in Sebnitz.

There are two cash dispensers 3 km away on the Market Square in Sebnitz.

Local arrangements

Practicing and competitions are only allowed between 7 a.m. and 8 p.m.

There is a hospital in the vicinity of the World Championship Centre.

F2B Timing Clarification

The current rule book written procedures for both entering the circle (at the start of an Official Flight) and for preparing to/actually starting motor/s contain some discrepancies which cause confusion, viz:

QUOTE: 4.2.5. There is an attempt when the model aircraft does not become airborne within three minutes of the starting signal, or the competitor does not enter the circle within two minutes from being called to fly UNQUOTE:

and

QUOTE: 4.2.11.... This 7 minutes time limit commences when the participant gives a hand signal prior to starting his motor, but no later than 3 minutes from the moment he has entered the circle.

UNQUOTE:

Thus the current rules:

- a) are partly confusing (different content);
- b) are partly wrong (QUOTE: no later than 3 minutes from the moment he has entered the circle UNQUOTE: is wrong);
- c) does not allow for the present practice of allowing the pilot to choose the position of the judges (additional time required)

Clarification:

In recent contests (including WC 2000) a modified version of the rules to cover these discrepancies has been used successfully and was accepted by the competitors.

The 2002 F2B World Championships in Sebnitz will use the above procedure, which is described in full as follows:

QUOTE: After entering the circle the competitor is allowed to check wind direction, choose his Take-off point on the circle, and position the judges accordingly. At that time the Circle Marshal will then ask the competitor to confirm his readiness. At the moment confirmed by the competitor the Circle Marshal will start timing the 3 minutes limit after which the model must become airborne. Exceeding that 3 minutes limit will be registered as an Attempt. The 7 minutes time limit allowed to complete the Official Flight starts within this 3 minutes limit, at the moment when the competitor gives his hand signal. UNQUOTE:

Note that the present 2 minutes rule (time allowed to enter the circle) remains in force when using this new procedure.
